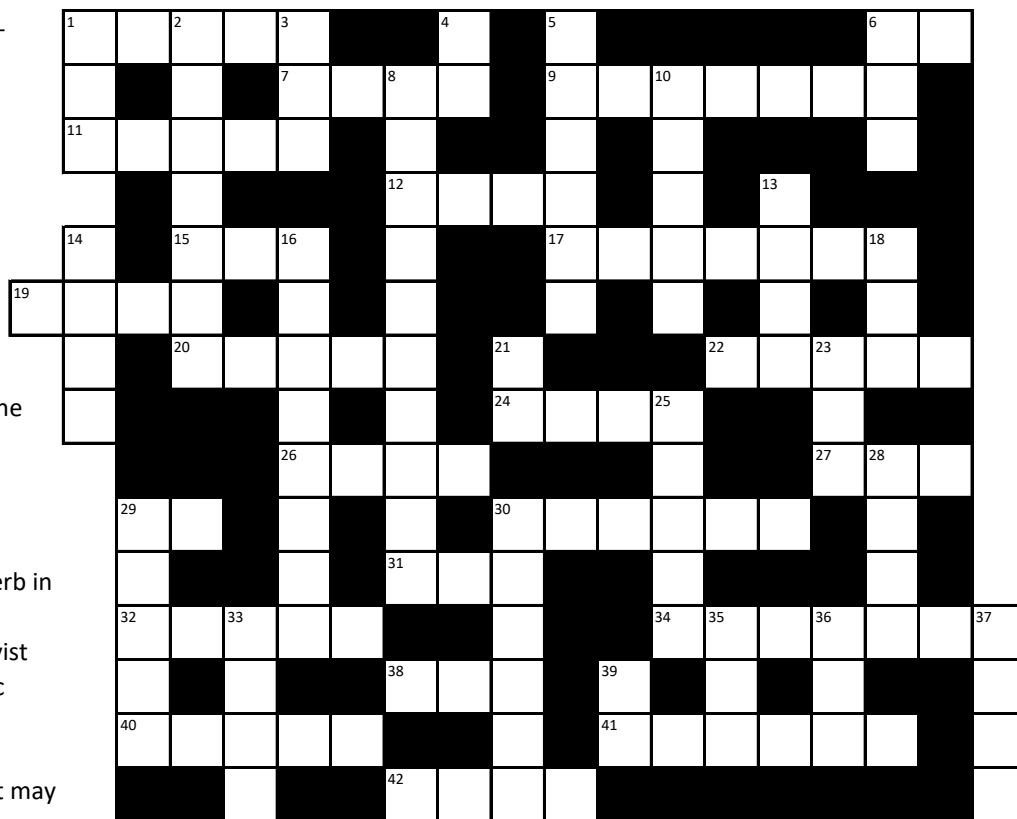


The Brilliant Crossword
